

PROGRAMMING EXAMPLES FOR BARE METAL C

The examples for *Bare Metal C* come in two forms:

1. Examples that stand by themselves (*bare-examples.zip*)
2. Examples that are STM32 Workbench projects (*bare-ide.zip*)

Bare Examples

To use the bare examples, unzip the *bare-examples.zip* folder. You will get a set of directories, one per example. To compile an example:

```
$ cd <directory>  
$ make
```

Or if you are on Windows:

```
$ cd <directory>  
$ make -f Makefile.windows
```

Bare IDE Examples

To get the IDE examples:

1. Start the IDE.
2. Select **File** ▶ **Import**.
3. In the Import dialog, select **General** ▶ **Existing Projects into Workspace**.
4. Click **Next**.
5. Select the **Archive File** option and use the **Browse** button to select the *bar-ide.zip* archive.
6. A list of projects will appear in the Projects window.
7. Select the ones you want and click **Finish**.

The selected projects will be imported into your IDE.
